There has been a great interest displayed by the Rotary Clubs of Lima, the Peace Corps and Food for the Hungry.

All these organizations have begun to ask how they can get a machine into the communities where they work.

A new and improved machine is scheduled for the community of Huycan very soon.

We have had such an awesome response to our request for an opportunity to purchase a vehicle. So far we have received \$5,725 cash and pledges! Now we just need \$1845 more to complete the purchase and to get it ready to pull the Mobile Shop Classroom.

Albendazole Project-Peru

We have referred to this project by many names. It has been called "The Worm Project" or "sPill the News", but the objective is still the same.

This objective is to provide Albendazole 400 mg and hygiene education every six months to groups of people suffering continuously from intestinal parasites. This is about 18 million of the 30 million people that live in Peru today.

We are networking with several organizations for the consistent distribution of Albendazole in the areas most needed. At this time we are meeting with leaders from the Rotary clubs, Peace Corps, Food for the Hungry and FINCA-Peru.

Carol has also been named as chairperson of a commission created by a Peruvian congress lady to develop a pilot project to distribute Albendazole in the hard to reach areas of the Andes Mountains.
