Jeff and Chesley spent several hours looking at tools and equipment needed for the **Shop in a Box Project**. They believe everything needed is here in Lima. Most of it is at the ACE Home Centers which are located all over Lima.

We are still looking for a Peruvian Rotary Club for the **Well Drilling Project**. We believe when the time is right God will give us the right connection.

God is allowing us to meet many people from this country interested in raising the standards in Peru.

There have also been many meetings with other missionaries and organizations interested in putting together the **Worm Project**. Most people recognize the problem and want to be part of the solution.

Carol and I are in Peru these six months specifically to learn the Spanish language, to study the Peruvian culture and to network with groups here that can help fund our mission work.

Well.....the Spanish is poco a poco, we're eating new and different foods and riding everywhere in Combis. (They call grits here polenta! Ever tried eating a polenta. It just doesn't sound right.) And, God is tying our net with strong cords and some really good knots.

We have met with someone almost everyday since arriving on May 29.

Of all the projects we have talked and written about, we have known that God ultimately wants us to build a missionary training center. This center will be our home base and a demonstration site for all that we are to teach. God has given us the vision, plan and curriculum. We have been waiting seven years for HIM to provide the land, buildings, and money.

On June 21, we met with Senior Pastor Robert Berriger of the Camino de Vida church. This is the church we attend while here in Lima. He has been praying for God to send an agricultural missionary couple to Peru to administrate a Children's Home located on a 500 acre working ranch in the Cuzco area. When he heard of our vision for training leaders in the areas of agriculture, appropriate technology, health, nutrition and hygiene, he asked if we could administrate the children's home ranch and together build the training center there.

We are seeking God's wisdom on this. We believe that God is ordering our steps!! Please join us as we continue to pray and seek God. We are depending on your prayers as God is stretching our faith daily.
